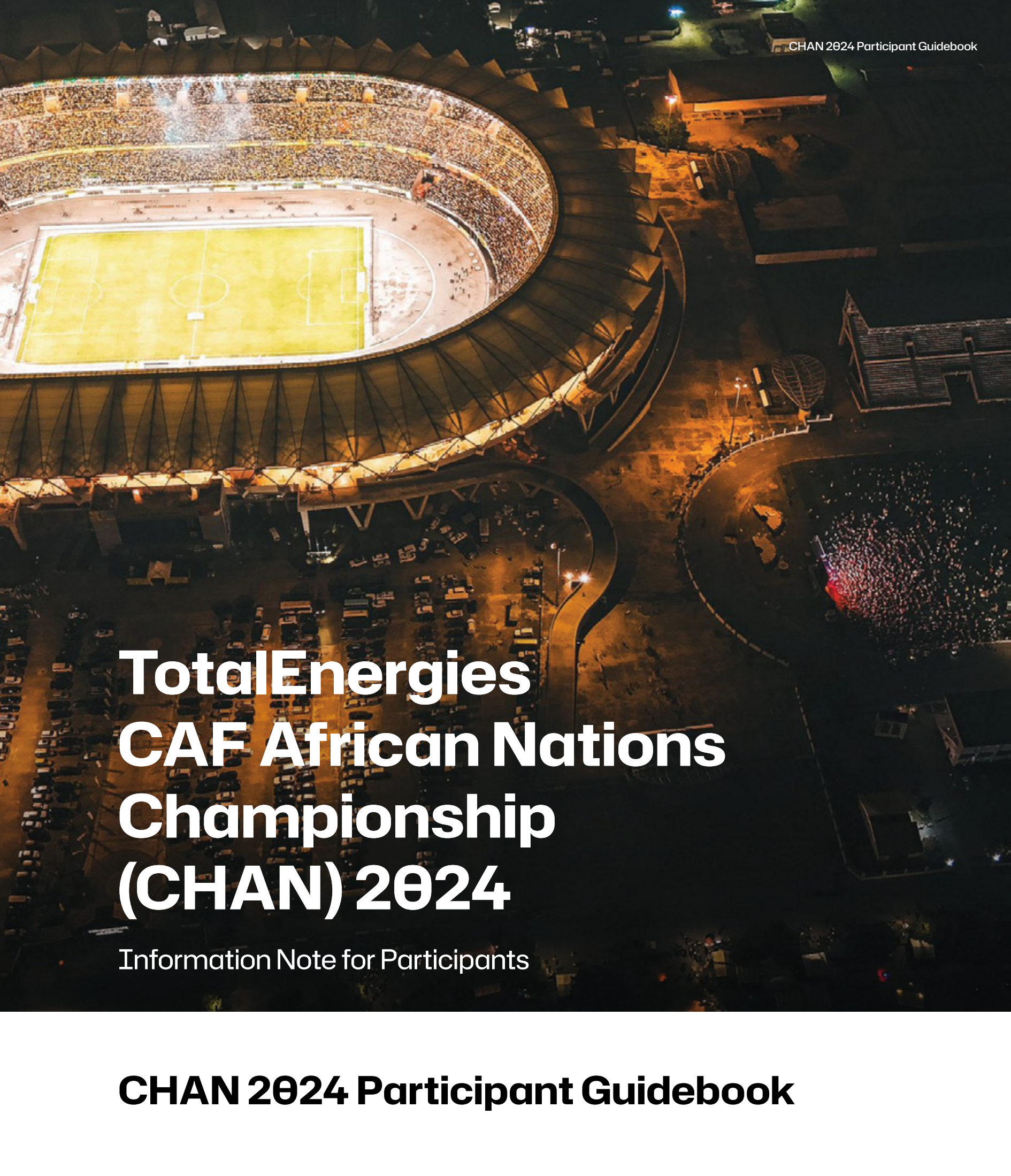

Introduction to the Host Country and Cities

The United Republic of Tanzania, located on the eastern coast of Africa within the African Great Lakes region, will proudly host the **TotalEnergies CAF African Nations Championship (CHAN) 2024** from **2nd to 30th August 2025**. With a territory spanning **945,234 km²**, Tanzania ranks as the **13th largest country in Africa** and the **31st largest in the world**. Bordered by the Indian Ocean to the east, **Lake Victoria** to the north, **Lake Tanganyika** to the west, and **Lake Nyasa** to the southwest, the country boasts diverse geographic and climatic features, rising from Mean Sea Level (MSL) to peaks approaching **6,000 meters above MSL**.

The CHAN 2024 tournament will be hosted across two vibrant Tanzanian cities: **Dar es Salaam** and **Zanzibar**. **Group B matches** and the knockout stage—including the final—will take place at the **Benjamin Mkapa Stadium** in Dar es Salaam. **Group D matches** will be held at the **Amaan Stadium** in **Zanzibar**. These cities offer an exceptional blend of **modern infrastructure, cultural richness, and coastal beauty**, making them ideal venues for this **prestigious continental football event**.

Dar es Salaam, Tanzania's largest city and economic powerhouse, is strategically situated along the **Indian Ocean**. It is a hub for accommodation, tourism, and entertainment, offering a vibrant urban experience for players and fans alike. Meanwhile, Zanzibar, the semi-autonomous archipelago famous for its **historic Stone Town** and **pristine beaches**, provides a **unique** and scenic backdrop that adds **cultural depth** to the **championship atmosphere**.

Although **Dodoma** is the political capital of Tanzania, **Dar es Salaam** remains the country's commercial center. Visitors to Tanzania will find it helpful to note that:

- **Time Zone:** UTC+3
- **Country Code:** +255
- **Languages:** The national language is **Kiswahili**, while both **English** and **Swahili** are official languages

Travel Information

a) Visa Requirements

Visa may be required to enter Tanzania depending on one's nationality or country. Citizens of East African Community and SADC Member States do not require visa to enter Tanzania. One must have a passport valid for at least six months to apply for a visa. Participants are required to consult visa application guidelines and online visa application service with the Tanzania Immigration Services Department at <https://www.immigration.go.tz/index.php/immigration-services/visa-information>.

b) Specific border entry requirements and restrictions

Among the requirements is that, The Ministry of Health in Tanzania and Zanzibar require all travelers to show a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate at all ports of entry. Currency declaration for any cash amount exceeding **10,000 USD** or equivalent amount in other currencies is required.

Local Transportation

a. Airport Transfer

Upon arrival at **Julius Nyerere International Airport**, participants may use public transport) which is available at the airport, there is a taxi stand located directly outside the exit of Julius Nyerere International Airport.

The approximate taxi fare from the airport to City Centre is **\$30 USD**. Julius Nyerere International Airport is approximately **12km** from the **Dar es Salaam** city centre. Cars registered under **Uber** or **BOLT** is also recommended from the airport to the hotels in city center.

b) Public transportation within the city

i. Taxi

Taxis are available at all major hotels in Dar es Salaam and nearby taxi stations. Cars registered under Uber or BOLT are also recommended mode of transport that participants can use. Participants are advised to use registered public transport vehicles.

ii. Car Rentals

There are few reliable car rental companies in Dar es Salaam, Arusha, and Zanzibar regions. However, you are advised to consult with the hotel for further advice on selecting a reliable car rental office.

iii. Mini Van / Motorcycles / Bajaj

Mini Vans (Dala-Dala), Motorcycles (Piki-Piki) and Bajaj (Tuk-Tuk) are mostly used by local residents for transport. However, participants are advised to use registered tax or Uber for local transport in all the movements within Dar es Salaam or elsewhere.

iv. Bus

A new Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) network with exclusive lanes is growing in Dar Es Salaam and has significantly improved local commuting times. (Not recommended)

Currency and Use of Credit Cards

The local currency is the Tanzanian shilling (TZS). Foreign currency can be exchanged in banks or at authorized Forex exchange shops available in town or at the airport. It is advisable to exchange money only at registered and licensed outlets. Hotels may also exchange at a more or less similar rate.

Major banks with bureau de change services include:

- **National Bank of Commerce (NBC)**

- **Standard Chartered Bank**

Credit and Debit Cards, as well as cash, are widely accepted in major hotels, restaurants, and shops as a mode of accommodation and payment. **ATMs** are safe to use, with a maximum cash withdrawal of **TZS 1,000,000.00** per transaction, and banks may charge a withdrawal fee of up to **USD 7** per transaction

Electricity

The standard electrical current used throughout the United Republic of Tanzania is 230 volts with a frequency of 50 Hz.

The electric plugs and sockets are of the G type. It is recommended that participants bring their own adaptors to comply with the electric current and plugs.

Telecommunications

There are seven mobile cellphone providers in Tanzania:

- **TTCL**
- **Smile**
- **Vodacom**
- **YAS**
- **Airtel**
- **Halotel**

All providers offer 3G, 4G, and 5G services, with good network coverage in Dar es Salaam and other cities and towns across the country. Mobile internet connections are generally fast and reliable in most areas. WhatsApp is widely used for communication throughout the country and is the preferred messaging platform for both personal and business use.

Health Advisory

a) Protection against diseases

Protection against mosquitoes bites is recommended to avoid contracting mosquito borne diseases such as Malaria. Most hotels are equipped with mosquito nets and repellents are widely available.

It is not recommended to use medical drugs without advice from medical specialists.

All visitors to Tanzania should seek medical advice and prescription of prophylactic drugs. Tap water may not be safe participants are advised to use bottle/mineral water for drinking.

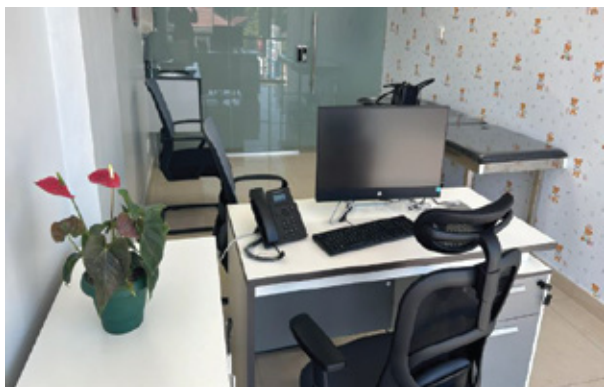

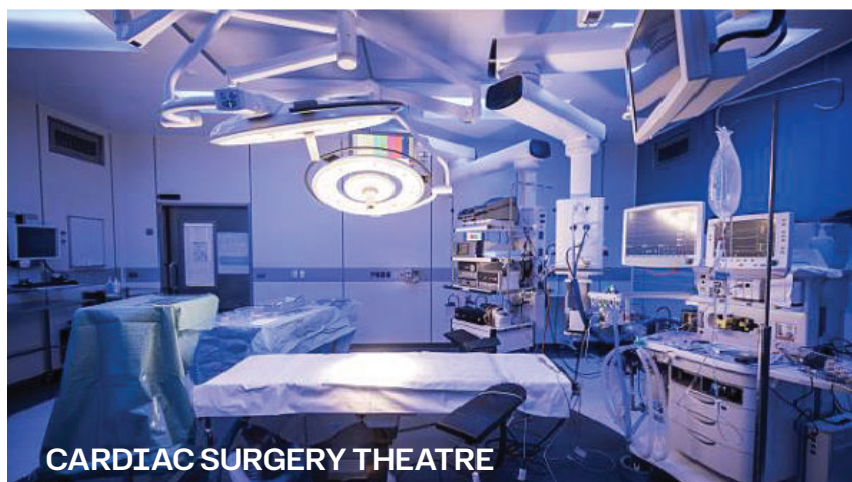

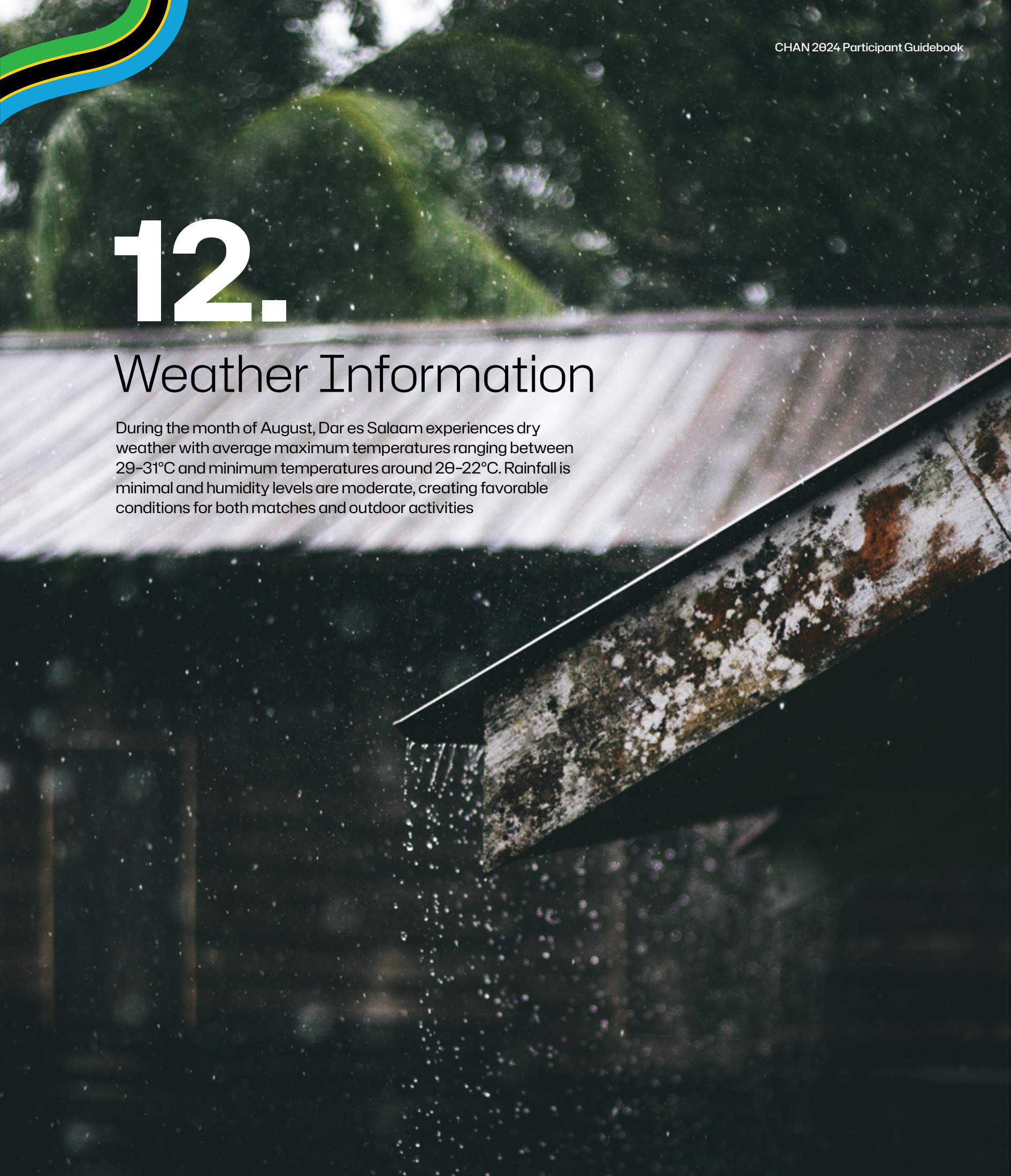
d) Travel Insurance

Weather Information

During the month of August, Dar es Salaam experiences dry weather with average maximum temperatures ranging between 29–31°C and minimum temperatures around 20–22°C. Rainfall is minimal and humidity levels are moderate, creating favorable conditions for both matches and outdoor activities
